- and casts into sharp relief the crisis in the Church today,
 - in our lives (families),
 - → in the world.





What is the Mass?

"Forasmuch as, in this divine sacrifice which is celebrated in the Mass, that same Christ is contained and immolated in an unbloody manner, who once offered Himself in a bloody manner on the altar of the cross; the holy Synod teaches, that this sacrifice is truly propitiatory and that by means thereof this is effected, that we obtain mercy, and find grace in seasonable aid, if we draw nigh unto God [cf. Heb. 7:25], contrite and penitent, with a sincere heart and upright faith, with fear and reverence. For the Lord, appeased by the oblation thereof, and granting the grace and gift of penitence, forgives even heinous crimes and sins. For the Victim is one and the same, the same now offering by the ministry of priests, who then offered Himself on the cross, the manner alone of offering being different."

[Council of Trent, Session 22, Chapter 2]

What is the Mass?

The one same perpetual Sacrifice of Christ offered in an unbloody manner, through the ministry of His ordained priests, on behalf of His Mystical Body, to render unto the Triune God the perfect worship of adoration, thanks, impetration and reparation for man's sin, thereby pouring forth into souls His divine grace.








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- ★ The Mass is **THEOCENTRIC**





Theocentric vs. Anthropocentric

- ★ If we lose [weaken, dilute, mitigate] these elements of adoration, then we no longer treat God as God.
 - We usurp God's divine Throne.
 - We uncrown Christ our King.



I ADORE...

- If we lose [weaken, dilute, mitigate] these elements of adoration, then we no longer treat God as God.
- By not giving God fitting worship, we shut off the principal channel of grace!

I BELIEVE... THANKSGIVING



At Mass...

we must express and hand-on the True Faith.

I ask pardon for those who do not believe.

I BELIEVE...

- One's salvation does depend upon one faithfully adhering to the **True Faith**.
- The greatest mysteries of our Faith are transmitted through the Mass.



I BELIEVE...

- Salvation does depend upon faithfully holding the True Faith.
- Greatest mysteries of Faith are transmitted through the Mass.
- To have Faith we must believe what God has **REVEALED**. (Recall the *Act of Faith*.)





BELIEVE...

- Salvation does depend upon faithfully holding the True Faith.
- To have Faith we must believe what God has revealed.
- ▼ If the *lex orandi* (worship / Mass) is changed, then there is a corresponding change in the *lex credendi* (faith / dogma).







I BELIEVE...

- Salvation does depend upon faithfully holding the True Faith.
- To have Faith we must believe what God has revealed.
- If the lex orandi changes, the lex credendi changes to match.
- ▼ The New Mass underwent a devastating revolution that has made it **anthropocentric**.







I BELIEVE...

- Salvation does depend upon faithfully holding the True Faith.
- If the lex orandi changes, the lex credendi changes to match.
- The liturgical revolution made the New Mass anthropocentric.
- Mankind can't help but fall into a **terrible** crisis when the True Faith is changed.





I HOPE...

 Hope keeps our soul fixed upon our **Final End** and helps us evaluate all things in light of that Ultimate Purpose.



I HOPE...

- Hope keeps our soul fixed upon our Final End.
- ▼ Indispensable to hope is a constant meditation upon the Four Last Things.
- † Death
- † Hell
- **†** Judgment
- Heaven



- Of 1182 proper prayers in the Tridentine Missal, 760 were entirely omitted (64%).
 Half of those remaining prayers were altered to meet the "new theology."
- → This means the New Mass only contains 17% of the proper prayers' lex credendi.

I HOPE...

- Hope keeps our soul fixed upon our Final End.
- Indispensable to hope is meditating on the Four Last Things.
- Notably absent are:
- Detachment from the world (the Cross!)
- * "Negative" theology (man's sinfulness, weakness, wretchedness)
- Prayers for the Dead (Purgatory, Limbo, Requiem)
- Merits of the Saints (Our Lady, St. Michael)
- Miracles (St. Philomena, St. Christopher)
- * "New Ecumenism" (heresy, error, conversion, one True Faith)

I HOPE...

- Hope keeps our soul fixed upon our Final End.
- Indispensable to hope is meditating on the Four Last Things.
- Six areas are notably absent from proper prayers.
- Consider these radical changes in light of the Vision at Tuy and the Errors of Russia.



I LOVE... REPARATION At Mass... we must [learn to] love God above all things. I ask pardon for those who do not love.

I LOVE...

- Love of God
- ☼ Holiness consists in a two-fold movement: [1] love of God and [2] hatred for sin.
- To love God (and *grow* in that love) we must [1] obey God and [2] make reparation for sin.



I LOVE...



- Love of neighbor
- Love: To desire and choose the good for the other, no matter the sacrifice to oneself
- Charity: The ultimate good is Heaven. I must desire Heaven for the other and act accordingly no matter the sacrifice to myself. (Victim Souls)
