Tenn. State Tigers -J-State Tigers Look to Rebound in Southern Heritage Classic

Welcome to the twentieth renewal of the Southern Heritage Classic. Tonight's opponent is Jackson State University. The J-State Tigers and Tenn. State Tigers series dates back to 1949 with Tennessee State holding a 23-18-2 edge in the overall series and a 10-7 edge in their Southern Heritage Classic match-ups. Last year, TSU beat J-State 41-18 for their sixth win in a row over JSU.

Both teams suffered opening game losses and hope to show a renewed effort in tonight's game to get into the winning column. With the exception of last year's 41-18 win by TSU, the two teams had gone to overtime in their three previous years, with TSU winning each one.

Tennessee State coach James Webster gained his first collegiate coaching win over J-State in 2005 with a 20-14 overtime win and has beaten JSU coach Rick Comegy each of the three years they have faced each other.

Tennessee State has played in every Southern Heritage Classic, since its inception in 1990, and shows a 10-9 record in the classic. Jackson State's last win over TSU in the Southern Heritage Classic was in 2002, when they fashioned a 31-28 victory.

This Week's Game

Tennessee State University will look to get back on track from a disappointing 24-7 loss to Alabama A&M, when they face Jackson State in the 20th Annual Southern Heritage Classic in Memphis, Tenn. Kick-off is scheduled for 6 p.m. inside the Liberty Bowl.

TSU (0-1) leads the overall series 23-18-2 and the SHC series between the squads, 10-7. The Tigers have won the last six outings against J-State including a 41-18 win last year in the SHC (09/13/08).

Last week, TSU dropped the season opener in a 24-7 loss to Alabama A&M at LP Field totaling 191 yards in offense. Two quarterbacks combined for 14-of-38 passing with the Tigers unsuccessfully running the ball tallying 13 rushing yards.

Starting quarterback Dominic Grooms went 4 of 8 passing for 42 yards before going down with a hamstring injury in the third quarter and will sit out this week. Reserve quarterback Jeremy Perry, a product of Memphis' Woodale High School, connected 10 of 30 passes for 136 yards throwing two interceptions and was sacked twice.

By mid-week Coach James Webster had not named a starter this week's match-up as of yet but quarterbacks Calvin Mc-Nairl and Michael Becker are in reserve. McNairl is nursing an injury suffered during camp and is day-to-day.

The Tigers' defense was responsible for their only score and are led by Eugene Clifford and Anthony Levine. Clifford returned a school record 78-yard fumble late in the first quarter to give TSU their only score. Clifford finished with

seven tackles (5 solo, 2 assists) with Levine leading all defenders with eight tackles (6 solo, 2 assists) and was named the defensive MVP.

Jackson State (D-1) opened their season with a 45-7 loss to SEC foe Mississippi State in Starkville, Mississippi at Davis Wade Stadium. JSU registered 194 yards of total offense but held MSU to 14 points at the half.

Returning quarterback Trae Rutland completed 8 of 19 passes for 132 yards throwing two interceptions. Rutland also carried the ball 14 times for 46 yards. The J-State Tigers scored late in the game on a 16-yard run by Terrence Davis. Davis collected two carries for 24 yards. Darius Bolela averaged 4.7 yards per carry with 28 yards from six attempts.

In the SWAC preseason poll, JSU was picked to win the Eastern Division with several players making the first and second preseason teams. Defensive lineman Sam Washington was named to the first team. Kicker Eric Perri, linebacker Marcus Jamison, and defensive backs Malcolm Palmer and Marcel Young received second-team honors.

Perri and Palmer were named to last year's All-SWAC Second Team. Against MSU, Palmer finished with a game high 11 tackles (6 solo, 5 assists), including one for a loss, a forced fumble and a pass break-up. Jamison followed with six tackles to help lead the JSU defense.

Record Return

Eugene Clifford's 78 yard fumble return for a TD against Alabama A&M (09/05/09) is the longest in modern TSU football history. The previous record was 73 yards, set by Shaun Richardson against Austin Peay (09/15/07).

Head Coach - James Webster, Jr.

- Webster made an immediate impact on the Tigers program since being named head coach in Jan. 2005. After a 2-9 year and 1-6 mark (eighth place) in the OVC in his first season, the Tigers were back above .500 in year No. 2 (6-5) and won four more Conference games, as they finished 5-2 and were third in the OVC. It marked just the third winning season in the last seven years and equaled the most Conference wins since 2003. Tennessee State repeated that third place OVC finish in 2007, finishing 4-3 in OVC play.
- With over 31 years of coaching experience, Webster has had many impressive stops on his resume. He was an assistant at his alma mater - North Carolina - to begin his career (1973) and later coached at Florida (1974), Kansas (1975-78). Colorado (1979-81),Northwestern (1982-84), Wake Forest (1988-93), Dartmouth (1993-95) and East Carolina (1995-00) before returning to UNC in 2001 (and staying until 2004). He has also had experience working with the Pittsburgh Steelers and St. Louis Rams in the NFL.

- Webster has coached teams in the 1979 Sugar Bowl, 1976 Sun Bowl, 1988 Independence Bowl, 1998 Liberty Bowl, 1999 Mobile Bowl, 2001 Peach Bowl and 2004 Continental Tire Bowl.
- As a coach at North Carolina, Webster coached All-American Julius Peppers, the 2001 Lombardi and Bednarik award winner. Peppers was drafted No. 2 overall (by Carolina) in the 2002 NFL Draft. UNC ranked 15th nationally in total defense in 2001.
- As a player at North Carolina (1968-72), Webster started at linebacker for three consecutive seasons. He was named the Defensive MVP of the 1971 Gator Bowl.
