BIRMINGHAM, Ala. – The Southwestern Athletic Conference has selected Alabama A&M University center Justan Banks as its SWAC Men's Basketball Player of the Week for March 10.

Justan Banks**Alabama A&M****7-1*Center* Oxford, Ala.**

Banks manufactured back to back double-doubles to close out the regular season and his career as a Bulldog. Last Thursday against Jackson State, he scored 13 points and grabbed 13 rebounds while also blocking four shots in a 72-59 victory over JSU.

Banks nearly repeated his same performance Saturday hosting Grambling State when he scored 14 points to go along with 12 rebounds, three assist, and three blocks as AAMU topped GSU 80-63.

The Oxford, Alabama native is being tabbed with the weekly honor for the first time this season as this was also his first set of double-doubles this year as well.

The Golden Lions never trailed, building a 42-33 halftime advantage and leading by as many as 19 in the second half en route to their ninth win in their last 11 games.

Anthony McDonald and Jeffrey Simmons each scored 14 points for MVSU (9-22, 5-13), which has lost eight of its last nine and was playing its first game under interim head coach Marcus Thomas after former head coach Chico Potts was reassigned to another position.



PRAIRIE VIEW A&M

HOUSTON – Alabama State University outscored Prairie View by three in a 90-87 overtime victory Monday night at the Williams Nicks Center.

Tied at 77 at the end of regulation, ASU (16-11, 10-6) outscored PVAMU 13-10 in OT to clinch the win.

Bobby Brown scored 22 points and grabbed 13 rebounds to lift the Hornets who snapped a two game losing streak.

Maurice Strong, DeMarcus Robinson and Billy Ingram contributed 11 points apiece for the Hornets, who shot 51 percent from the field and cling to a second-place conference tie with Texas Southern. Jamel Waters and Tony Armstrong added 10 points each in the win.

The Panthers (8-20, 6-10) led 35-34 at the break but sank fewer shots from the penalty stripe and from 3-point range in the game.

Montrael Scott led the Panthers with 25 points, John Brisco added 24 and Demondre Chapman 22 in a losing effort for Prairie View.



SOUTHERN

BATON ROUGE, La. – Texas Southern University defeated Southern 67-64 Saturday night at the F.G. Clark Activity Center. The victory earned them the second seed in the 2014 Toyota SWAC Basketball Tournament which starts Tuesday in Houston.

Jose Rodriguez scored 18 points and Lawrence Johnson-Danner added 13 for the Tigers.

TSU (16-14, 12-6) opened with a 9-0 run capped by a three pointer by Johnson-Danner. Southern used a 9-2 run to close to 20-19, but the Tigers pulled ahead with two more threes by Johnson-Danner and led 35-27 at halftime.

The Jaguars (19-12, 15-3) used an 8-2 second half run to close to 39-35, then pulled ahead 57-54 on a trey by Tre Lynch. Yondarius Johnson scored five straight points and Southern led 62-61 at 2:47, but Texas Southern rallied for a 65-62 lead on free throws by Johnson-Danner. Calvin Godfrey missed a game-tying free throw for Southern and Johnson-Danner iced the win with two free throws of his own.

Johnson led Southern with 12, Javan Mitchell scored 10, and Calvin Godfrey and Malcom Miller chipped in 10 each. The Braves are now (11-17,8-8).

Johnson led Southern with 12, Javan Mitchell scored 10, and Calvin Godfrey and Malcom Miller chipped in 10 each.
