**CONFERENCE NEWS & NOTES**

Texas Southern was held a season-low 55 points in a Feb. 6 loss to Prairie View A&M. It was also the lowest point total for TSU in conference play dating back to the 2011 season. Prior to that game, the Tigers had been held to 55 points by a SWAC opponent only one other time in the past four-plus seasons. The opponent? Prairie View A&M, who defeated Texas Southern 58-55 on Feb. 7, 2015.

Monday Alcorn State won its second straight game after topping Grambling State 66-63 Monday night. Since Jan. 11, the Braves have gone 7-1.

The past two seasons, the Jackson State Tigers have finished with 11 wins. In 2014, they won seven SWAC games. Last season, they improved that mark to nine. This season, JSU has already won 8 games in the league. For the first time since 2010-11, Coach Brent's team has a chance to finish with double digit conference wins. That same season they finished 12-6 in

## PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**BIRMINGHAM, Ala. –** Southern guard Adrian Rodgers has been named Southwestern Athletic Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week. This is the first time Rodgers or anyone from the Jaguars have earned the weekly honor. The junior college transfer posted a career and game high 30 points in Southern's 79-66 road win at Grambling State Saturday night. On Monday, his hot shooting carried over against Jackson State when the senior guard dropped 26 points in an 81-80 loss.



### The NCAA automatic qualifier shall be the winner of the Conference postseason tournament:

**A.** If the tournament is won by an NCAA tournament-eligible team, that team gets the AQ. If the tournament is won by a team ineligible for NCAA postseason, the team (among those eligible for the NCAA tournament) that advances the furthest in the SWAC tournament will be the league's AQ. If two or more NCAA tournament-eligible teams are eliminated in the same round of the conference tournament (i.e. the tournament's semifinals), the tie-breaking procedure utilized by the league to seed the championship will break the tie to determine the higher-seeded team as the automatic qualifier. For example, if the SWAC tournament championship game features two teams that are ineligible for the tournament, and both defeated tournament-eligible teams to advance to the final, the tiebreaker would go to the semifinal loser that was the highest-seeded team in the conference tournament.

**B.** In the event the tournament cannot be played or is not played to completion, the Conference regular season champion shall be the automatic qualifier, if the regular season champion is not eligible for the NCAA tournament, the AQ will be awarded to the highest eligible finishing regular season team.

**C.** In the event of a tie for seeding, the following procedures will be used:

- 1). Two-team ties:
  - a). Head-to Head competition
  - b). Point Differential between the tied teams if the season series is split
  - c). Record against highest seeded team (proceed downward) until the tie is broken
  - d). Coin Toss
- 2). Ties involving three or more teams:
  - a). Record between teams that are tied (Won-Lost-Record)
  - b). If still tied, record against the highest seed & proceed downward
  - c). Coin-Toss

GREENWOOD, Miss. – A pair of Marcus Romain free throws with seven seconds left lifted Mississippi Valley State over Alabama A&M 66-64 Monday night.

Romain scored 25 points, including two fouls shots to seal the victory for MVSU. His three point play with 49 seconds to go gave the Delta Devils a two-point lead.

On the next possession, Vacha Vaughn fouled Nicholas West, and the senior sank both free throws to tie the game for the eighth time with 35 seconds remaining.

MVSU then held the ball as long as they could before Romain was fouled again. He made both to put MVSU back up by two, and Ladarius Tabb's last-second jumper was off the mark.

Southern (16-8, 8-3) led 50-34 at the break. The Tigers (13-11, 8-3) trimmed their deficit to six with 11 minutes to play.

Two free throws by Chris Thomas extended Southern's lead to 76-66 with 4:36 to go, but Jackson State scored 12 straight and took its first lead since 2-0 with 1:30 remaining.

Jarred Sam converted a three point play before Adrian Rodgers hit 1 of 2 free throws to give the Jaguars an 80-78 advantage with seven seconds to play, but Franklin hit his only three of the game which proved to be the game winner.

Rodgers led Southern with 26 points. Two days after he scored 30 against Grambling State.

## PRAIRIE VIEW A&M

PRAIRIE VIEW, Texas – Jayrn Johnson scored 21 points and swatted three shots as Prairie View A&M upset Texas Southern 59-55 on Saturday at the William Nicks Building to give interim coach Byron Smith his first win.



Texas Southern experienced one of its worst shooting nights of the season, going 16-of-56 (28.6 percent) from the floor. The Tigers (10-12, 9-1) particularly struggled from long range, only shooting 2-of-21 from behind the arc. The 55 points scored is a season-low for the Tigers.

Prairie View A&M (2-20, 2-8) got a 3-point play from Admassu Williams that put the Panthers up 48-40 with 8:06 to play. After the Panthers went up 51-42, Texas Southern went on a 7-1 run and Malcom Riley's layup cut the deficit to 52-49. Riley then made a 3 with 20 seconds to go, trimming it to 54-52. PVAMU would use free throws down the stretch to preserve the win, which halts a seven-game skid.
