

## ProVantage 2019 Gift to Lundy-Fetterman School of Business



ProVantage Corporate Solutions, LLC has had a blessed and profitable year and desires to donate to the Lundy-Fetterman School as part of its yearly tithing. ProVantage will award a summer 2019 Internship with our company for up to two students from the Lundy-Fetterman School of Business. ProVantage will also be donating a total of two \$10,000 Direct Aid Scholarships to two additional students. (Students may apply for the internship, scholarship, or for both the internship and scholarship. Not all interns will receive scholarships and not all scholarship recipients will receive internships.)

**Internship Program** – ProVantage Corporate Solutions, LLC – Students who have obtained junior status (64 credit hours) and have a GPA of 3.0 will be eligible to apply for this internship. (A lower GPA may be acceptable if extenuating circumstances exist.) An application form must be submitted. Each student must write a 1000-word essay explaining the Biblical principles set forth in Larry Burkett’s *Business by the Book* and how they may conflict with principles commonly used in today’s business world. ProVantage will review these essays and select applicants to interview for a paid internship with ProVantage Corporate Solutions the summer prior to their senior year. ProVantage will offer two students these internships in Raleigh, NC. At the conclusion of their internship, students will receive a review of job performance.

### **Direct Aid Scholarships** – Rose Providential Advantage Scholarship

Two \$10,000 direct aid scholarships will be awarded for the 2019-2020 academic year to two students who will be seniors in 2019-20. A scholarship committee composed of two representatives from ProVantage Corporate Solutions, the Dean of the School of Business and at least two School of Business faculty members will determine the recipients. This scholarship may not be awarded to an employee or employee’s family member of ProVantage.

Applicants for the Rose Providential Advantage Scholarship must:

1. Submit an application by Noon, January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019 to Mrs. Greffeuille in digital and paper formats.
2. A student must have junior status (64 hours) in the Spring 2019 semester and a GPA of at least 3.0. Students may apply only if they have at least two remaining semesters.
3. The student must have a major in Accounting, Business Administration, Economics, Finance, International Business, or Marketing.
4. Write a 1000-word essay describing how you would use Biblical principles set forth in Larry Burkett’s *Business by the Book* in your future professional development plans for the next five years. Describe how this may be different from the principles typically used in “today’s world.”
5. The student must submit a 250-word personal statement of need for the scholarship assistance.
