Parking information: There are a variety of lots around campus. The closest for most of our buildings this year are the 10th Street Structure, Fulton Structure, and Apache Structure. In years past, there have been free structures on weekends – as of January 1st, 2019 all ASU lots are pay lots 24/7.

Bus drop off information: Closest to tournament HQ: Forest Avenue L, southwest corner of campus, next to Gammage Hall. Next closest: The Myrtle/10th Street L on the Northwest side of campus. Least convenient: north section of McAlister Avenue, runs through eastern half of campus. - **Online Registration** – **If you are fully paid or have provided a complete Purchase Order** to the tournament, **you do not need to physically attend registration**. Go to asu.tabroom.com, click the

- **Registration** – Thursday, 5-7pm, SS 105 (you may register your entire team at this time). Again, this is only for schools still owing money that are not paying by Purchase order.

- **Student Lounges – LSA 191** – All postings will be available here. This is immediately adjacent to tournament HQ and central to most events, minus Policy Debate.
- **ALL Ballots are online this year, including congress** – Online only. The ballot assistance table and judges lounge will be **SS 105**. Instructions for signing up, receiving, and entering ballots will be posted at www.hdshcinvitational.com/judge-info -- You can also check help at tabroom.com
- **Speech judge training, including online ballot demonstration 8:30am Friday, SS 105**
- **ALL judges must check in at SS 105 each morning, or when they arrive.** If you do not have a ballot for an assigned event, you are on standby and should be prepared for us to call/text you a ballot as a replacement judge.
- **Snacks for judges (SS Atrium):** We will provide breakfast and unlimited snacks all three days. Coffee and water all weekend as well. It's important that judges and students not eat in competition rooms.

- **PF/LD/Policy awards** – No awards ceremony to hand out speaker awards. We will publish a list and students can pick up their awards in SS 236. This is designed to speed up debate elimination rounds on Sunday. ALL teams participating in elim rounds can pick up their trophies here as well.
- **Congress/Speech awards** will be held in the Student Pavilion Auditorium (STPAV) at 6pm Sunday.

Special Tabroom.com features. We require all judges and students to create accounts at Tabroom.com to get the most out of the online features it has to offer. **This is required for ALL judges.** Anyone with an account can receive texts and/or emails of the pairings or look them up at asu.tabroom.com. Students can claim their entry at the tournament and receive online notifications of their pending rounds. Judges will receive their ballots online. Coaches can choose to receive notifications for any of their students.
