#### **Division Breakdown:**

This is a two division tournament: Novice and Junior Varsity will compete and Varsity

JUNIOR VARSITY: Debaters in their 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year of debate VARSITY: Anyone with more than 2 years of experience

#### Fees:

PF: \$25/team

LD: \$25/competitor Total amount paid at registration. Receipt available at request.

#### **Judging:**

1 judge required for every 2 teams

Ex: 4 PF teams and 2LD competitors=3 judges

We can hire judges for a team at \$250/judge. Please let us know ahead of time if you need a judge.

Varsity debaters can judge novice divisions.
