



## Climate Refugees Act (2018)

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The Immigration and Nationality Act (1965) shall be amended to include  
3 climate change displaced persons as eligible for refugee status.

4 **SECTION 2.** A quota of 100,000 eligible climate change displaced person shall be  
5 granted refugee status each fiscal year in perpetuity.

6 **SECTION 3.** Climate change displaced persons shall be defined as individuals  
7 originating from a foreign country whose lives and/or livelihoods have  
8 been directly threatened by anthropogenically induced sea-level rise,  
9 extreme weather, and/or drought.

10 **SECTION 4.** The United States Citizenship & Immigration Services and Immigration &  
11 Customs Enforcement shall be responsible for enforcement and oversight  
12 of this legislation

13 **SECTION 5.** This legislation will take effect immediately upon passage.

14 **SECTION 6.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

## Responsible Immigration Enforcement Act (2018)

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** Section 287(g) of the Immigration and Nationality Act of (1965) shall  
3 hereby be repealed.

4 **SECTION 2.** The Department of Homeland Security shall hereby be prohibited from  
5 offering incentivizes to state and local law enforcement agencies to assist  
6 in immigration enforcement, and shall be prohibited from attempting to  
7 coerce state and local law enforcement to assist in immigration  
8 enforcement.

9 **SECTION 2.** This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.

10 **SECTION 3.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
