

## **Climate Refugees Act (2018)**

1	BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:				
2	SECTION 1.	The Immigration and Nationality Act (1965) shall be amended to include			
3		climate change displaced persons as eligible for refugee status.			
4	SECTION 2.	A quota of 100,000 eligible climate change displaced person shall be			
5		granted refugee status each fiscal year in perpetuity.			
6	SECTION 3.	Climate change displaced persons shall be defined as individuals			
7		originating from a foreign country whose lives and/or livelihoods have			
8		been directly threated by anthropogenically induced sea-level rise,			
9		extreme weather, and/or drought.			
10	SECTION 4.	The United States Citizenship & Immigration Services and Immigration &			
11		Customs Enforcement shall be responsible for enforcement and oversight			
12		of this legislation			
13	SECTION 5.	This legislation will take effect immediately upon passage.			
1/	SECTION 6	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void

## **Responsible Immigration Enforcement Act (2018)**

1	BE IT ENACTED	BY THE	CONGRESS HERE	ASSEMBLED THAT:
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- SECTION 1. Section 287(g) of the Immigration and Nationality Act of (1965) shall hereby be repealed.
- SECTION 2. The Department of Homeland Security shall hereby be prohibited from offering incentivizes to state and local law enforcement agencies to assist in immigration enforcement, and shall be prohibited from attempting to coerce state and local law enforcement to assist in immigration enforcement.
- 9 **SECTION 2.** This legislation shall take effect immediately upon passage.
- SECTION 3. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
