On behalf of Darien High School and Coaches Dennis Cummings and Leslie Bradshaw, Farmington High School and Coach Joel Nick, and King School and Coach Ian Lear-Nickum, I would like to invite you to attend our last regular tournament of the 2018-19 season on Saturday, March 2. We will follow our standard tournament format.

Please read the following items carefully:

1. We have three hosts and expect to have room for all wishing to debate. However, to make sure the tournaments are relatively equal in size, we would prefer that schools sign up for events at the locations indicated:

These assignments are based on attendance counts at tournaments this year and result in about the same number of teams at each location. If you would like to switch, please email me first. If you are a school not on the list, please email me and tell me which location you prefer and how many teams you would like to bring.

We appreciate registrations with approximate numbers by Saturday evening, February 23, so we can give the host schools a reasonable estimate of attendance.

2. You must register your teams and judges through tabroom.com. Instructions for using tabroom.com for CDA can be found here: <http://ctdebate.org/PDFs/Using%20Tabroom.pdf>. We will be using tabroom.com for registration for all tournaments.

All teams will be wait-listed on entry so that we can review them. We will confirm entry over the weekend of February 23-24.

The tournament entry on tabroom.com has three events, Varsity, Novice and Observer, for each location. Observers are welcome, but must be registered if you would like them to receive copies of the resolution package

The tournament will be open for registration on Tuesday, February 19 at 8AM.

4. Please abide by the rules for Novice eligibility (unchanged from last year):

The Novice division will be open to Freshman and Sophomores, regardless of experience or record. They may qualify and participate as Novices in State Finals both years. However, they may move up to Varsity at any time if they or their coach choose, and once having moved up, may not return to Novice. Coaches are encouraged to move Sophomores up to Varsity if they have been successful as a Freshman, but are not required to do so.

Juniors who have never debated before in CDA may participate as Novices in their first regular CDA tournament. Otherwise they may only debate in Varsity. They may not participate in State Finals except in Varsity. They may only qualify for State Finals while debating in Varsity.

Seniors may not participate as Novices in any CDA tournament.

5. To qualify for State Finals, a debater must win a trophy at a regular tournament, or go 3-0 at two regular tournaments. In other words, simply going 3-0 at one tournament without winning a trophy will not qualify.
