Events: All NCFL events. No double entries. No more than SIX entries per event prior to Grand Finals. No more than 12 entries in Congress prior to NSDA District Congress.

Novice students may be registered as **student observers** to watch rounds in up to four events. There is no entry fee, but observers still incur the host/lunch fee.

Cost: \$20.00 per competitor (includes entry fee and host/lunch fee) PLUS an additional \$10.00 host/lunch fee for each judge, trainee, or observer. Checks should be made out to FGCCFL for the full amount.

Food: Closed campus (FGCCFL rule). Please remember to order lunches on Tabroom for all competitors, judges, trainees, coaches, and observers. ONE complimentary lunch will be provided to each school for the head coach. Lunch will be Shepherd's Pie (meat or vegetarian), salad with dressing, breadsticks, dessert, and drinks. Please order lunches on Tabroom.

Judging requirements: One (1) judge for every four (4) IE and Congress entries combined. One (1) judge for every two (2) LD entries. One (1) judge for every two (2) PFD team entries. One (1) judge for each TD team entry. **COACHES:** Do not count yourself in your judge quota as we must be able to use you where needed! Judges should be cross-trained.

A judge training will be held at this tournament. Trainees incur only the host/lunch fee and do not count toward the school's quota.

Registration for the Tournament

Go to <fgccfloct.tabroom.com> and click on the "Register" tab. Registration must be submitted online by the school's coach only. Registration will not be accepted once Tabroom registration is closed or by any means other than Tabroom unless directed to do so. Pay attention to your school registration for students, judges in correct pools, and total lunch orders. Tabroom registration will close at 9:00 P.M. on the Monday of the tournament week.

Please note: The Executive Committee will levy additional tournament fees of \$25.00 for any dropped entry on the tournament day, a dropped entry not declared before the start of the first round, and for each missing judge. All changes made after the close of registration but before tournament day must be reported to Paul Jannereth at pjannereth@carrollwooddayschool.org. Schools will forfeit registration fees for all drops after the close of online registration.

Tournament day registration: 7:30–8:00 in the Media Center. Only the team coach or principal-approved designee should proceed through the registration line. Students should report to **the Cafeteria**. Judges should report to **the Media Center**.

Congress Legislation Requirements

Every school entering Student Congress **MUST** supply at least one (1) and at most six (6) pieces of satisfactory legislation. All legislation must be written using the <u>templates</u> on the FGCCFL website and **UPLOADED to Tabroom** by 9:00 P.M. on the THURSDAY **prior to tournament week**. Late, frivolous, stale, recycled, or unsatisfactory legislation **will not** be considered. The legislative docket will be published on FRIDAY evening, allowing students a week to prepare.

Directions

From the South via I-75: Take I-75 north to I-275 north. Cross the Sunshine Skyway into St. Petersburg and proceed to exit 26B (54th Ave N westbound). Proceed west on 54th Ave N for about 3.4 miles to 62nd St N. Turn left. The school is ahead on your right.

From the North via I-75: Take I-75 south to I-275 south. Cross the Howard Frankland Bridge into St. Petersburg and take exit 26 (54th Ave N). Turn right and proceed west on 54th Ave N for about 3.4 miles to 62nd St N. Turn left. The school is ahead on your right.

From Tampa via I-275: Take I-275 south across the Howard Frankland Bridge into St. Petersburg. Take exit 26 (54th Ave N), turn right, and proceed west on 54th Ave N for about 3.4 miles to 62nd St N. Turn left. The school is ahead on your right.

From East Hillsborough via I-4: Take I-4 west to I-275 south. Cross the Howard Frankland Bridge into St. Petersburg and take exit 26 (54th Ave N). Turn right and proceed west on 54th Ave N for about 3.4 miles to 62nd St N. Turn left. The school is ahead on your right.

Parking: The gated parking lot is just before the school building and Marques.
