
Dear Students:

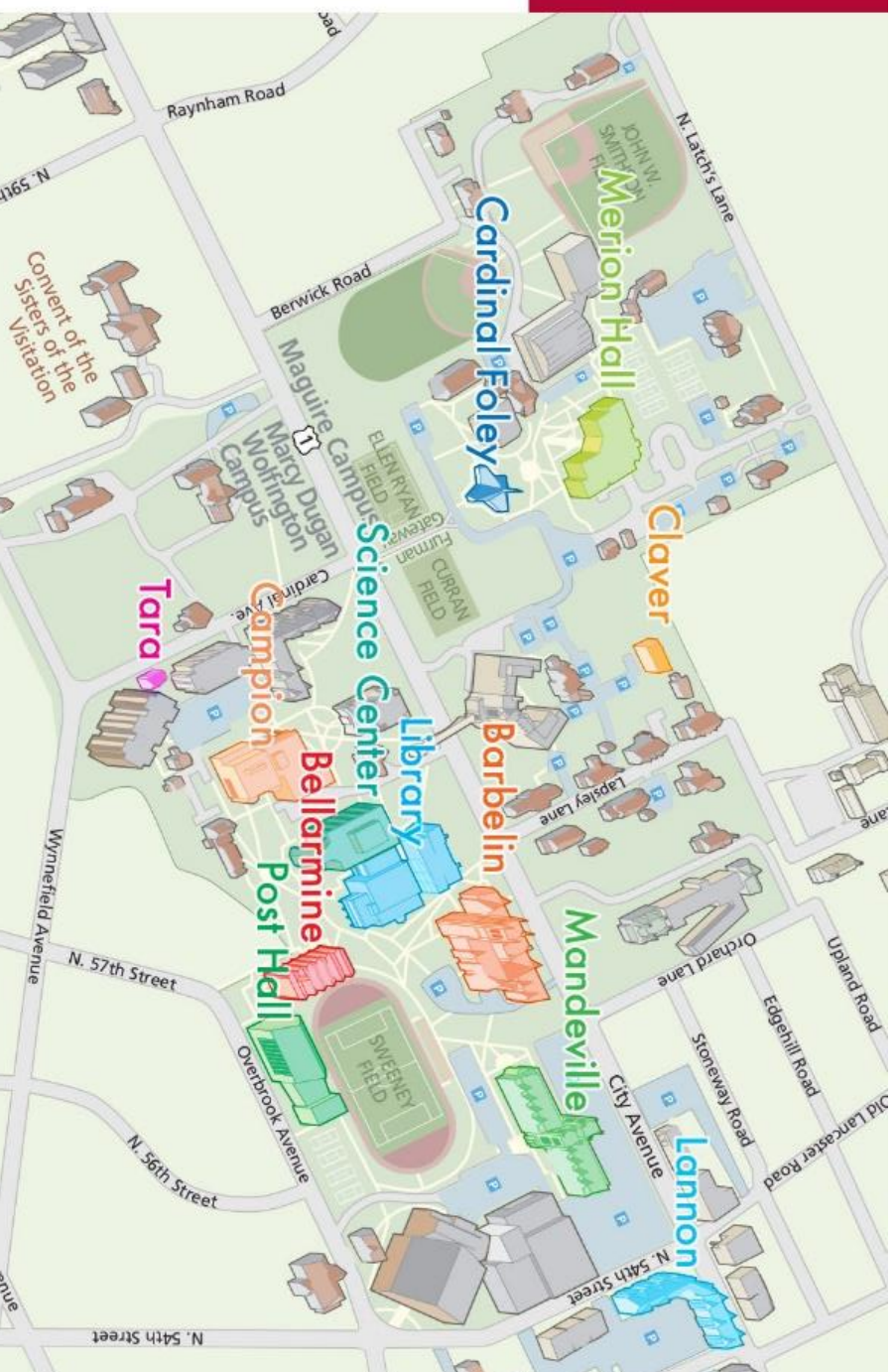

FOOD

Campion Dining Hall is the classic, all you can eat dining hall in the basement of the Campion Student Center. Students can buy wristbands there for unlimited access all day, all you can eat; a pass for Saturday and Sunday is \$25. A one-day pass is \$15. Students can pay cash/credit at the cash registers at the entrance.

IF YOU ARE A PUBLIC FORUM DEBATER OR PUBLIC FORUM JUDGE YOU ARE STRONGLY ADVISED TO *NOT* BUY THE TWO DAY PASS. Einstein's' Bagels will be open on Saturday in Merion Hall (where public forum is) will be open 8 am to 8 pm on Saturday. On Sunday, feel free to buy the one day pass into Campion for Sunday, as you will not be in Merion Hall on Sunday.

For dinner, the Campion Food Court (containing York Street Deli, Grille Works, and Hawk Wrap) will be open from 5 pm to 11 pm both Sunday and Saturday.

Starbucks will be open from 8 am to 5pm Sunday and Saturday, located beneath Hawks Landing.
