# 2018 Big Apple Round Robin

## **A Bill to Disband the National Collegiate Athletic Association**

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** Disbands the 501 (c)(3) non-profit National Collegiate Athletic Association  
3 (NCAA).

4 **SECTION 2.** The Department of Education will oversee this legislation.

5 A. The DoE will be responsible for forming a new organization to oversee  
6 the functions previously served by the NCAA.

7 B. The Secretary of Education will appoint the leader of the new  
8 organization.

9 **SECTION 3.** This bill will go into effect January 1, 2020.

10 **SECTION 4.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

# 2018 Big Apple Round Robin

## **A Bill to Prevent Conflict of Interest in Court Cases Involving the President**

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** Federal judges must recuse themselves from all cases involving the  
3 President of the United States of America if said judges were appointed  
4 to a judgeship by the President over the course of their careers. This  
5 includes, but is not limited to, cases involving:

6 **A.** Criminal suits involving the President.

7 **B.** Civil suits involving the President.

8 **C.** Cases involving the President's immediate family members.

9 **SECTION 2.** The Department of Justice will implement this policy.

10 **SECTION 4.** This bill will go into effect immediately upon passage.

11 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

# 2018 Big Apple Round Robin

## **A Bill to Restore the State and Local Tax (SALT) Deduction**

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The State and Local Tax (SALT) Deduction will be fully restored.

3 **SECTION 2.** Taxpayers who itemize will be entitled to unlimited deductions on their  
4 state individual income, sales and property taxes.

5 A. Eligible taxpayers can deduct state and local property or real estate  
6 taxes, and either state and local income or sales taxes.

7 **SECTION 3.** The Congressional Budget Office, working jointly with the House Ways  
8 and Means Committee and the Joint Committee on Taxation, will  
9 implement and enforce with legislation.

10 **SECTION 4.** This bill will go into effect immediately upon passage.

11 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

# 2018 Big Apple Round Robin

## A Bill to Ban Company Quarterly Reporting

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** Upon passage of this legislation, all publicly traded companies are  
3 prohibited from quarterly reporting. All publicly traded companies will be  
4 required to file one report at the end of each fiscal year.

5 **SECTION 2.** A quarterly report is defined as a 10-Q form. Companies will only submit  
6 a 10-K form at the end of each fiscal year.

7 **SECTION 3.** The Securities and Exchange Commission will be responsible for the  
8 implementation and enforcement of this legislation.

9 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will go into effect at the start of FY20.

10 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

# 2018 Big Apple Round Robin

## A Bill to Make Tariffs Taxes to Stabilize Trade

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** Tariffs shall henceforth be considered a form of taxation. This will ensure  
3 the solely the House of Representatives can impose tariffs.

4 **SECTION 2.** A tariff shall be defined as a tax or duty on imported or exported goods.

5

6 **SECTION 3.** U.S. Customs and Border Protection will be responsible for the  
7 implementation of this legislation.

8 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will be implemented immediately upon passage.

9 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

# 2018 Big Apple Round Robin

## A Bill to Regulate Social Media to Protect American Values

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** All social media platforms with a user base exceeding 50,000 people will  
3 be subject to semiannual government inspections regarding foreign  
4 influences. Such platforms will be required to establish detection  
5 protocols and submit semiannual reports on the success of these  
6 protocols to the U.S. government.

7 **SECTION 2.** A social media platform shall be defined as websites and applications that  
8 enable users to create and share content or to participate in social  
9 networking. The definition of foreign influences shall be used from 22  
10 U.S. Code § 611.

11 **SECTION 3.** The United States Cyber Command (CYBERCOM) will be responsible for  
12 overseeing this legislation.

13 A. CYBERCOM shall conduct inspections and analyze reports from the  
14 social media platforms. CYBERCOM will also make recommendations  
15 to platforms to help improve security.

16 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will be implemented on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019.

17 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
