You must register online through the site—it's simple. Plus, you'll be free to manipulate your entry. If you run into problems, call or e-mail me.

DEADLINE: Registration opens August 1. Entries are due by noon on Thursday, September 15.

FEES: \$35 per 4-person team. \$30 per Switch Sides team. \$25 per Public Forum team. \$20 per Lincoln Douglas debater. \$125 per hired judge.

JUDGES: 1 judge required for each 2 entries. A single judge may cover 1 LD and 1 PF entry if they are willing to judge both. You must supply separate 4-person and switch sides judges, however. Limited hired judges available for \$125.

DIVISIONS: 4-Person Policy, Varsity Switch Sides, Novice Switch Sides, Public Forum, and Lincoln Douglas.

We will be using the October Public Forum topic.
