FOX INVITATIONAL DEBATE AND IE TOURNAMENT

Silverton High School welcomes you once again to compete in our beautiful small town!

The tournament will be held Saturday, November 10th, 2018. We offer L.D. Value, Parli, Public Forum, and Policy (CX) Debate. We also offer all State individual events. Awards will be given out to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams/competitors in Open Division and Novice Divisions. Certificates will be presented to finalists in all divisions and outstanding individual speakers in debate. We also plan to offer Sweepstakes Awards to the top 3 schools.

REGISTRATION:

- Initial registration is due Monday, November 5th at 4:00 pm.
- Changes to your registration will be accepted until 5:00 pm on Wednesday, November 7th. Fees will be assessed at that time.
- Due to spatial constraints, it is likely we will need to close registration early; please get your complete registration in as early as possible. Remember: it is always easier to drop students than to add them.
- Drops: If you have drops after we close registration, we will allow you to make those online yourself. However, we will assess fees on Wednesday the 7th at 5:00 pm; any drops made after that time will still be charged.

IE DIVISIONS:

- Novice Division: Limited to students with NO SPEAKING EXPERIENCE IN HIGH SCHOOL COMPETITION BEFORE THE 2018-2019 school year.
- Open Division: Open to all students.
- Note: Divisions may be collapsed if there are insufficient entries.

PATTERNS:

Pattern A: CX, Parli, Duo, Radio, Prose, POI, Inform, Extemp

Pattern B: LD, PoFo, Impromptu, HI, ADS, LIBIELL, Oratory, DI, Poetry

CONFLICTS:

- 1. Students may enter 2 conflicting Individual Events per pattern *at their own risk*. We do not recommend entering two 10-minute events in the same pattern.
- 2. Debaters may not enter an IE in the same pattern as their debate event.
- 3. Extemp will prep in the hour of their pattern it will be important that Extempers are not late to the prep room!

Entry Limitations:

First Come-First Served:

- 1. Debate: Teams are limited to 3 debate entries per style of debate and division.
- 2. Please limit IE entries to a maximum of 10 per event TOTAL spread out 5 and 5 in both divisions (5 in Novice, 5 in Open).

**If you have a request for a different configuration, please email us (Katie AND Stephen). Requests for entries OVER the total limit for a school will not be considered.

FOOD:

Our FBLA is opening the Fox Shop during the tournament from 7:00 am until mid-afternoon, and will be selling breakfast food, beverages, snacks, and lunch options. We will also have pizza for sale. The Fox Shop can run cards, but pizza must be paid for in cash. Unfortunately, there are no local food establishments within walking distance. We will provide food for judges.

RULES:

- *LINCOLN-DOUGLAS VALUE DEBATE: We will use the 2018 November/December NSDA Topic and use OSAA rules Novice topic will NOT be used.
- *PARLIAMENTARY DEBATE: We will use OSAA rules. Students may only use a dictionary to prepare their cases. 15 minutes prep. Students will prep in their competition rooms.
- *PUBLIC FORUM DEBATE: We will use OSAA rules. The 2018 November Public Forum Topic shall be used.
- *CROSS EXAMINATION DEBATE: We will use OSAA rules. The 2018-2019 CX Debate Topic will be used, and Novice Case Area limitations will be in effect.
- *For all IE events, OSAA State rules will apply.

JUDGES:

Each team must provide 1 coach available to supervise students and judge throughout the tournament. If your coach is unable to attend, please inform the tournament director of the name of the adult in charge.

- *One judge covers 6 entries.
- *Please make comments in the notes about which of your judges feel comfortable to judge CX. We will try to prefer those judges, but please understand that judges may be asked to judge outside of their "comfort zone."
- **Judges covering entries are expected to be available throughout entire tournament.

TRAVEL NOTE:

Please make sure your driver does not take you to the old campus! Our address is:
