

## **Fairview Freeze**

You are invited to Fairview High School on Saturday, December 1, 2018!

Note: We know there are a lot of tournaments this weekend -- if we do not have enough entries for several sections of events on Nov 1 we will cancel so schools can attend elsewhere. Let us know you are interested by registering early!

## Our tournament will run as follows:

- No entry limits will be imposed, we will take entries until we're full
- If you enter many competitors in a single event, your students may hit one another
- Team entries will be charged as individual entries
- All rounds will be powered
- All undefeated debaters will break to finals, subject to judge availability
- Places will be determined by win-loss, strength of opp, and speaker points
- All students will be permitted to double enter between waves (one Wave A, one Wave B i.e. no triple entering of any kind)
- Events will use NSDA rules with NSDA topics (CHSAA for Value Debate, Impromptu and Creative Storytelling with impromptu draw in room)
- Trophies will be given to the top three finishers in all events
- Places four through six will receive ribbons and all finalists will be recognized
- Team awards will be determined by percentage of entries, not total numbers

## A few things to note:

- We are not doing congress this year
- A coach or responsible adult must be on-site at all times and checked into judge or in tab (This is so we know how to locate you in case of accident or incident)
- Enter from the top part of the school where registration will take place
- All cars and buses should be parked in the senior parking lot, which is just beyond the main circle drive on Greenbriar
- Fairview ramps are STEEP, please keep your students from running or playing on them
- Fast food is not available within walking distance from the school, food will be available
- Breakfast, lunch, and snacks will be provided for judges and coaches
- Students are expected to remain in the Student Center when not competing
- Please do not enter classrooms before judges are present
- Note that all tobacco use and products are not permitted on the Fairview campus

- Rounds will be run as quickly as possible: postings may be earlier than scheduled
- Wave A: CX, LD, HI, DI, OO, INF, Impromptu
- Wave B: PF, Value Debate, Extemp, Duo, PI, Creative Storytelling, POI

**Finals:** 6:00 PM (Double breaks will be accommodated as needed)

Awards: 7:30 PM or as soon as possible

**Pre-Registration:** Pre-registration will be on Tabroom.com All numbers will be considered final on November 24th at 8am. Drops after this may be made online but will not reduce fees. No day of adds.

**Fees:** Entry fees will be \$9 per non-debate entry and \$12 per debate entry. Checks should be made payable to Fairview High School c/o Speech and Debate Team. **If at all possible, bring payment to registration instead of paying by mail.** 

**Judging and Tabulation:** In order to ensure that the meet runs on time, we will expect full participation from all coaches on site. We view the running of a tournament as a collaborative effort. This involves assignments ranging from judges table, to tab, and judging.

All coaches or parent chaperons must be willing and available to donate at least two rounds throughout the day. We ask you bring 1 speech/PF judge for every 6 entries and 1 LD/CX/Value Debate judge for every 4. Community members will be paid \$8 per round.

**Day of Event:** All dropped entries must be recorded by 7:20 AM. If you are running late, please call or text Kristina Getty at 303-710-5091.
