## RAVEN REVELRY INFORMATION CONTINUED

**ENTRIES:** You may enter an unlimited number of entries per event. Please have enough judges to cover your entries.

**REGISTRATION:** We will utilize the Tab Room website for registration. If you participated in the East OK District Tournament last March, you already have a Tab Room account. If not, visit www.tabroom.com and follow the instructions to set up an account. If you prefer to register manually, email dwright@riverfield.org for the registration forms. Please submit entry by 5pm on Monday, October 29, 2018.

FEES: \$3 for individual events; \$6 for duets; \$5 for LD; \$10 per CX and PF team

**DROPS/ADDS:** There is a \$5 drop/add fee for each event dropped/added after 5pm on Wednesday, October 31, 2018. CX/LD drops will be \$20 if dropped Friday, November 2, 2018, and \$40 for drops at the tournament or no-shows. IE drops are \$15 at the tourney and \$25 for no-shows.

**PAYMENT:** A school purchase order will be accepted. Invoices will be sent a week after the tournament. Please make checks payable to Riverfield Country Day School with Speech Tournament in the memo line.

**ORIGINAL ORATORIES:** Digital copies of original oratories will be accepted by email to dwright@riverfield.org. Alternately, printed copies of can be submitted at registration in individual, sealed envelopes with each student's name and school printed on it.

**JUDGES:** One judge is required for every two CX debate teams and one judge for every four LD debaters or portion thereof. The mandatory number for individual events is one judge for every 12 entries. There is \$25 fee per missing judge. As we are all aware, judges help make the tournament run smoothly, so PLEASE provide judges.

**AWARDS:** Our awards are a cut above, with big medals for 1st—3rd placements and impressive Sweepstakes trophies. In LD and CX debate, Top Speaker trophies go to the competitors with the highest speaker points in all three divisions. For Saturday events, Outstanding Competitor trophies are awarded to the student in all three divisions who earns the most Sweeps point for his/her school.

This year, the Revelry is adding a community service element by partnering with the Community Food Bank of Eastern Oklahoma. One in six Oklahomans deals with hunger every day, and the Food Bank works to meet this need by partnering with 360 agencies from Miami to McAlester to stock food pantries, emergency shelters, soup kitchens, senior adult centers, and after school programs. With the impending holiday season, the Food Bank faces its greatest need for donations.

For this Revelry, Raven Speech & Debate is asking teams to not only bring great talent and attitudes to our campus, but also donations of non0perishable food. We are happy to send a list of most needed items. The school that brings the most food will receive a special trophy at the Awards Assembly.
