You are cordially invited to the 1st Annual RCS Cougar Cup Varsity Invitational! This SPEECH, CONGRESS, and WORLD SCHOOLS competition will be held at Resurrection Christian School on Saturday, November 10th. This will be a great place to practice for the NIETOC Qualifier at Greeley Central the following week!

### **Tournament Highlights:**

**This tournament will be “I.E. Heaven”! No waiting on debate rounds to post or to finish, 4 prelim rounds for *all* interp and public address events, and the chance to double or TRIPLE enter!**

**Interp & Public Address Events:** HI, DI, POI, Poetry, Duo, Creative Storytelling, Info, OO, Impromptu, Congress

**Debate Event:** World Schools

**Doubling/Tripling:** Due to time, World Schools Competitors may ONLY enter in World Schools Debate, they may not double enter in Congress or other Interp or Public Address events. All other students may double or triple enter in Interp & Public Address events and Congress. Students who double or triple enter must be able to complete all of their entered events within the time scheduled for each round.

### **World Schools Prepared Motions:**

- **Round 1:** This House believes that social media platforms should be held responsible for content on their networks.
- **Round 3:** This House believes that governments should not fund the search for habitable territories in space.

**Congress:** Legislation should be sent to [asmith@rcschool.org](mailto:asmith@rcschool.org) by no later than *Friday, November 2, 2018*. Dockets will be compiled and posted on Monday, November 5<sup>th</sup> for students to begin researching and preparing. No walk on legislation will be allowed on the day of the tournament. Congress rounds will be

limited to 1 hour 15 minute sessions. Presiding Officer awards will go to the final person in each chamber who serves in this position.

**Judges:** We will be doing judges slightly differently, so please read carefully:

1. All schools are asked to bring 1 judge for every 8 entries. Coaches may be asked to judge rounds if schools do not cover their judge entries.
2. We ask that all schools register their judges ahead of time on Tabroom, especially those judges interested in judging World Schools debate. This also allows us to pair judges rounds ahead of time if possible.
3. We will pay the judges you bring \$8 per round and feed them great food all day. Just please guarantee they come!
