A fee of \$4 will be charged per slot (i.e. team debate is \$8). Changes can be made to that registration until *November 1 at 4pm* with no extra charge. There will <u>not</u> be on-site registration. A roster of students with school codes will be sent out Friday. Coaches are responsible for checking this list and making sure it is correct. MHSA Rules: For speech and debate, MHSA AA rules will apply. For drama and SPOI, B/C rules apply with noted exceptions. Double entries will be allowed. Please note that judge restrictions may be lifted if needed.

We encourage all coaches to review MHSA approved changes in the rulebook as this meet will be the first one with many changes.
