Location: All events will be held in the High School building.

Gathering Area for Students: All competitors will gather in the auditorium between rounds. Please emphasize that the students clean their messes up before leaving.

Lunch/Concessions: A full concessions will be offered at the high school cafeteria (where the students should eat their food) throughout the day. Our hospitality rooms will be open for coaches, judges, and bus drivers throughout the day in the home economics room. School purchase orders will be accepted at concessions.
