We will be using the November-December Public Forum and Lincoln-Douglas Resolutions:

Public Forum - Resolved: The United States federal government should impose price controls on the pharmaceutical industry.

Lincoln Douglas - Resolved: In a democracy, the public's right to know ought to be valued above the right to privacy of candidates for public office.

Entry Deadline

Judging Requirements

Each participating school is required to bring at least one judge for every two teams or fraction thereof in each division (PF or LD). Please make sure that all judges are familiar with the style of debate they are scheduled to judge. Varsity/JV judges must be 18 years of age or older and cannot be currently enrolled in high school. You may bring high school varsity debaters to judge the novice debates. Please indicate first-year-out judges and student judges as part of your registration. Also, please make sure to explain to your students the importance of teaching the novices during these rounds.

Awards

There will be the following awards in each division: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place trophies and medals for places 4, 5 and 6. There will be speaker awards for places 1 through 5.
