Registration is on TABROOM under Bronx Science Fall Local. Fees are \$6 per speaker (PF, and Cx are \$12 per entry) and should be paid to the NYCFL.

Judge ratios are 1 to 4 entries in PF and LD and 1 to 2 in Policy. Varsity debaters may judge all divisions.

We are offering Novice (First year students only) and Intermediate Levels of debate and we will run 3 rounds of debate. We will recognize all students with winning records.

NOVICE LD: Resolved: Civil disobedience in a democracy is morally justified.

Intermediate LD: Resolved: In a democracy, the public's right to know ought to be valued above the right to privacy of candidates for public office.

Novice and intermediate PF: Resolved: The United States federal government should impose price controls on the pharmaceutical industry.

Policy Debate: Resolved: The United States federal government should substantially reduce its restrictions on legal immigration to the United States.
