Student Website Registration Requirement

Beginning with the 2014-15 school year, only students officially registered as a member user on our website may compete in district competition.

Please Note: Allowing new member students who have not registered to compete at districts may jeopardize that student's qualification or alternate status and WILL affect the event entry count for the district. It is ESSENTIAL that the district committee confirm that all new students competing at the district tournament have registered on the website prior to the beginning of the district competition.

4. Congress:

* Please look over the NSDA website for information and details on congress. If your students can sign up for this event and speak once throughout the two days, it will benefit the district as a whole!

- * If you would like to write a bill or resolution, please email it to Kerry Bocko (kbocko@sayresd.org) by February 15th.
- * She will email bill packets prior to the tournament, so students have time to research.
- * If you would like any help with this please feel free to email Julie Larnard-Newbury or Kerry Bocko.

5. Judges:

- * All judges should have a general understanding of what each event is offered. We must place a certain number of judges in each event and follow strict guidelines to keep a pristine judging appearance. This means that ALL judges need to be able to judge any event. It is our goal to have judges in their comfort area, but we need everyone to be flexible.
- * If you have any former students judging, the committee asks that they have at least one year between graduating and judging at the district level. (Anyone who graduated in 2017 is not eligible to judge at this tournament.)
- * Please try to fill your judge's quota, we all know the # of judges available can make or break a tournament.
- * If you have any extra adults who will be with you, we would appreciate their names so we can use them as extra judges if needed.

6. National Qualifiers

<u>Speech and Debate events</u>: As long as there are 4 entries in the event then our district is eligible to send ONE students or ONE teams to the national tournament.

<u>Senate</u>: Our district is eligible to send two senators to the national tournament. House: We will have one chamber and be able to send TWO representatives.

7. District Student of the Year

- * Each school can nominate one senior to be eligible for the district student of the year.
- * A team of judges will be assigned to analysis the applications and choose the district student of the year.
- * The application for this process can be found on the NFL website and must be returned to Kerry Bocko by February 21st.

8. Team Strength

- a. Only students who have earned a minimum of 25 points and who have registered on the NSDA website (have a gold star by their name) may be entered.
- b. Please be sure to have all tournament points entered no later than Friday March 10th, only points entered at least one week prior to the start of the district tournament can be honored.
- c. Check your team strength in the 'manage schools' section, after all points have been entered. The chart below shows how many people you are able to bring to districts, depending on your team strength.
