

2019 MSM Forensics Festival

High School and Junior High Divisions Saturday, February 2nd

Mount St. Mary Academy's Forensics Team invites you to the 2nd annual MSM High School and Junior High School Forensics Festival February 2nd, 2019. We will offer a Saturday ONLY forensics tournament; no debate events. This is a qualifying tournament for the ACTAA Arkansas State Championship. Registration will open on Tabroom.com by Monday, January, 14th.

We are offering two thespian events in the high school tournament: Solo and Duet Musical. Students will be responsible for their own accompaniment. They are welcome to perform a cappella, with live accompaniment, or with recorded accompaniment (boombox, phone/iPod/Speaker). These will not be qualifiers for ASC, but we will be awarding the top six places.

Pattern A: DI, HI, Duo Interp, Oratory, Informative Speaking, Impromptu Solo Musical(no Junior H), and Duet Musical(no Junior H)

Pattern B: Prose, Poetry, Storytelling, Improv

NSDA IEs will have only one prelim round. Semis and Finals will be determined depending on the number of entries for each event. We will offer sweepstakes awards based on squad efficiency to high school and junior high schools. Note that the entry form asks for your school population number. We will have trophies and medals for top 6 finalists in IE's for High School and medals and certificates for Junior High finalists.

A \$25 school entry fee will be assessed. The deadline to register is 5pm Friday, January 25th. Additions and/or drops made after the deadline will have a \$10 fee per change. There is no cap on the number of entries; however, please make sure students understand NO ROUND WILL BE HELD TO ACCOMMODATE LATE STUDENTS. In order to promote fairness and efficiency please follow the judge commitment guideline of one judge per 10 IE entries. A \$10 missing judge fee will be applied. Judges will be offered hospitality for breakfast and lunch and our greatest appreciation!

Concessions will be provided for breakfast and lunch. Please do not bring outside food as this is a fundraiser for our program and remind students to keep food in cafeteria. Handicap and gender neutral restrooms are available. Please note other desired accommodations on Tabroom.com.
