

Hello coaches!

You are cordially invited to attend the Kapaun Forensics Tournament on February 22 and 23, 2019. We will be hosting Student Congress, Lincoln-Douglas, and Public Forum Debate on Friday night, and Individual Events on Saturday. We will be using the sunflower district legislation for Congress, The March/April topic for Lincoln-Douglas, and the March topic for Public Forum. These resolutions are as follows:

Lincoln-Douglas: Resolved—The illegal use of drugs ought to be treated as a matter of public health, not of criminal justice.

Public Forum: Resolved—The United States should promote the development of market rate housing in urban neighborhoods.

The Friday night events will have 4 rounds/sessions followed by awards. On Saturday, we will have 3 preliminary rounds followed by finals and awards.

Friday events:

We intend to have House and Senate at this tournament. We will add chambers as numbers need. I am asking all coaches to be available to serve as scorers. If you have someone who could judge Lincoln-Douglas or Public Forum we would love to have them. Awards will be given to the top 6 speakers each event. Friday entries are unlimited, please bring all students who are interested!

Saturday events:

On Saturday, we will be hosting the following events: Dramatic Interpretation, Humorous Interpretation, Duet Acting, Duo Interpretation, Prose, Poetry, POI, Impromptu, Informative (7 or 10), Original Oratory, International Extemp and Domestic Extemp. All events will have 3 rounds and finals. Schools may enter up to 25 entries with up to 6 entries in each event. After this, entries will be waitlisted. Students will be allowed to compete in 2 events with Impromptu as a third. Electronic retrieval will be allowed for Extemp prep. Awards will be given to the top 6 competitors in each event, with the top 3 schools receiving sweepstakes awards.
