The San Diego Middle School Debate League is not responsible for participants' safety; that responsibility lies in the chaperones for each school.
- 3. JUDGE APPROPRIATELY. If you are judging, please do not vote based on school affiliations. If there are any personal conflicts, you are expected to report this to the tournament directors before round. Please do not vote based off of factors other than speaking and argumentation skills.
- 4. PLEASE ARRIVE TO ROUNDS IN A TIMELY MANNER.
