

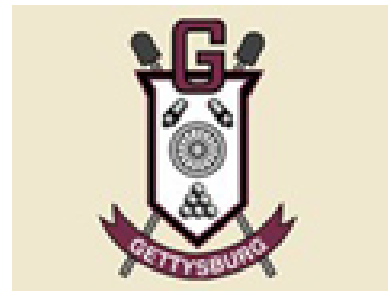
The Rhetorical Battle of Gettysburg Tournament
