4		military around a traditional enemy; and
5	WHEREAS,	the Department of Defense anticipates an attack of some sort against
6		South Korea at the hands of North Korea in the coming days; now,
7		therefore, be it
8	RESOLVED,	By the Congress here assembled that the United States stations 80% of its
9		forces in South Korea within 30 miles of the DMZ and the military moves
10		7,500 additional troops into South Korea from American military bases in
11		the region.
