This tournament will be held in the format established by the American Parliamentary Debate Association (APDA). We will release three resolutions 15 minutes prior to the start of each round. The resolution and side will be determined by coin toss, as at the Yale Invitational and Columbia Invitational, consistent with the APDA style.

Please note that although debate will be in a single open division, we may break to separate novice and varsity outrounds. We ask that you <u>appropriately mark you teams as either novice or varsity while registering via tabroom</u>.

#### Schedule

All debaters will participate in rounds on Friday and Saturday. Lunch on saturday is included with your tournament fee. Please note that there is a possibility that the tournament will run slightly over the time given in the schedule and that people should plan accordingly. This extra time will allow judges to provide detailed feedback and critiques.
