

Legislative Calendar

If all items on the regular calendar have been debated, the chamber may then consider the supplemental items at the bottom of this page. **No legislation may be added.**

*Starred items have been assigned to schools that did not submit satisfactory legislation of their own. The items and their sponsors were selected by draw and may not be changed, but the sponsorship speech may be declined, in which case a sponsor is chosen at large.
