Westview Invitational October 19th, 2019 Hosted at Westview High School

We are delighted to announce the reboot of the Westview High School Invitational. We value your time and effort for this early season tournament and are pleased to offer ALL students 4 rounds of competition (Round 4 are hidden Semi's) and a Round 5 Final!

Events Offered:

Open and Novice Divisions (small number events may collapse into "Open"). Novice Division is only open to students in their first year of competition and who haven't attended Camp. As is the norm, students who have high school competition experience in *any* event should not register as Novice, even for events in which he or she has not competed in before.

Pattern A: ADS, DI, DUO, OO, LIELL, Ext, POI, Big Question Debate, Parli Debate
Pattern B: Poetry, LDV, Inform, Imp, Prose, Radio, HI, Public Forum
Congressional Debate Pattern (conflicts with all other events)
Policy Debate Pattern (Conflicts with all other events)

Students may enter up to 2 events <u>per pattern</u> -or- 1 debate event <u>per pattern</u>. Due to the tight schedule, additional time in a round is not available for students with double entries. Students are responsible for managing their time to make it to their double-entered events in the time allotted for the round.

Restrictions:

Extempers in Pattern A may not have a second Pattern A event
 Policy Debate conflicts with all other events
 Congress conflicts with all other events

Entry Limitations

Each school may register 5 entries per event. Registration closes Thursday, Oct. 17th at 5 p.m. Registration can be found under "Westview Invitational" on tabroom.com, although be advised registration will close earlier in the event we reach capacity. Registrations are a first-come, first-served basis.

Judging Requirements

Each judge covers <u>four entries per pattern</u>. Schools with CX teams must have at least 1 additional judge for CX. Although the CX judge will be eligible to judge other events, that judge does not count towards the "one judge covering four entries per person". At least one adult from each school should be the designated student supervisor for that school. The student supervisor must remain on campus with students for the entirety of the tournament. <u>Please indicate on the registration the name of the responsible adult supervising the team.</u> Teams without a student supervisor will not be allowed to compete.

Due to the tight schedule, we will be using **on-line ballots**. <u>Each judge will need an electronic device</u>. We will have a limited number of laptops available for check out to judges for the day, so it is highly recommended judges bring his or her own wi-fi enabled electronic device.

Hospitality

On-campus breakfast, lunch, and dinner concessions will be available for cash purchase. Judges are provided free morning snacks as well as free lunch and dinner. There are local food options nearby. However, it is not recommended students leave campus due to the tight schedule. Accommodations are not available for students who miss a round for being off campus. Coaches are advised caution if allowing students to traverse the heavily trafficked roads near the school.

Event Rules

We will follow OSAA and NSDA event rules.

Awards and Sweepstakes

Trophies will be presented to the Top 3 in each event. Finalist are awarded certificates. Additionally, the top 3 speakers in each debate category will receive an award. A Tournament Champion Sweepstakes trophy will be presented to the school with the highest total sweepstakes point total using the following calculation method:

Sweepstakes Calculation

For All Speech Events:

First place is awarded 12 points

Second place is awarded 10 points

Third place is awarded 8 points

Fourth place is awarded 6 points

Fifth place is awarded 4 points

Sixth place is awarded 2 points

Non-advancing Semifinalists are awarded 1 point

For Congressional Debate:

First place is awarded 12 points

Second place is awarded 10 points

Third place is awarded 8 points

For All Debate Events:

First place is awarded 12 points

Second place is awarded 10 points

Advance to Semifinal is awarded 8 points
