Competition is open to novice speech team students in grades six through eight. There will be three rounds with two judges in each section. Each novice will perform one selection for three rounds with no final round. Instead of trophies, each novice who earns a ranking of #1, from at least one judge will be awarded a Certificate of Recognition at the end of the day.

- Registration on www.tabroom.com will be open October 13, 2019. Registration closes on Wednesday, October 23, 2019 at 5 p.m.
- If you plan on bringing more than 40 students, please contact me.
- Please provide *one* judge for every *four* students registered (one duo pair equals a single entry). Experienced middle school or high school students may judge as well as parents and teachers.
- The fee is \$7 per entry with \$14 per duo. Please make checks payable to The Pike School.
- Please note that there will be no food available for purchase. Students are welcome to bring their own nut-free snacks and lunches.

We will have paper ballots at the tournament but are excited to roll out online ballots for the November tournament. Coaches, please attend a brief meeting on online ballots after round 1 in the Community Room.
