A BILL TO AMEND THE "TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR NEEDY FAMILIES" (TANF) PROGRAM BY BETTER SPECIFYING AND LIMITING THE PEOPLE WHO ARE PERMITTED TO USE THE PROGRAM

1	BE IT EN	ACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:
2	Section 1.	The Amendment to the TANF program would create stricter criteria for a family
3		with dependent children or elders who are applying for the program. In addition
4		all adults who receive money via the TANF program will have to undergo a
5		random yearly drug test.
6	Section 2.	The Department of Health and Human Services will oversee the enforcement of
7		this bill by not giving financial aid to any family who does not qualify for the
8		program and hiring pharmacists to operate the annual drug test.
9		A. In order to be eligible to receive aid from the TANF program, one must have
10		at least two dependents living with them such as a child or a senior citizen, and
11		must be in search of a job.
12		B. Any adult who receives a positive result on the random drug test will no
13		longer be eligible to receive financial aid under the TANF program and will
14		immediately be cut off.
15	Section 3.	This bill will be implemented starting on January 1, 2021.
16	Section 4.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Establish a National Sales Tax

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1	SECTION 1.	(a) The United States Federal Income tax shall, for all income brackets, be
2		established at 0% and a National Sales tax shall be established in its place.
3		(b) The Internal Revenue Service shall be tasked with researching and
4		determining an appropriate National Sales Tax Rate, for fiscal year 2020, to
5		suggest to congress two months prior to Fiscal Year 2020.
6		(c) The suggestion made in subsection(b) is not one Congress is required to
7		utilize.
8	SECTION 2.	"National Sales Tax" shall defined as a tax levied upon consumers at the
9		point of sale for goods and services, calculated by applying a certain
10		percentage rate to the taxable price of a sale.
11	SECTION 3.	The Internal Revenue Service shall oversee the implementation of this
12		legislation.
13	SECTION 4.	Section 1 subsection(b) shall take effect immediately upon passage of this
14		legislation, while all other aspects of this legislation shall take effect upon
15		August 1, 2020.
16	SECTION 5.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Resolution to Restore Ethics to Congress

A Bill to Stop Patents on Genetically Modified Food

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- SECTION 1. No new patents shall be issued on livestock or agriculture which contains genetic modifications shall be issued to any for-profit corporation. All current patents for genetically modified agriculture or livestock will expire on January 1, 2020.
- SECTION 2. Genetic modifications include both artificial introduction of genetic materials in a laboratory, or selective breeding for such items as pesticide resistance, high crop yield, bacterial resistance, increased muscle mass, or improved taste.
- identify which patents fall under section one of this act. They will communicate which patents are invalid to the United States Patent Office for further action.
- **SECTION 4.** This will take effect upon passage.
- **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void. *Introduced for Congressional Debate by Upper St Clair High School.*

A Bill to Provide Student Loan Relief

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- SECTION 1. No federally funded student loan shall have a repayment schedule set until the recipient of said loan has earned a minimum of \$30,000 in a calendar year.
- **SECTION 2**. After verification of income, the loan repayment shall begin in the following calendar year.
- SECTION 3. The Internal Revenue Service shall verify income through federal tax reporting. They shall report to the Department of Education when a loan recipient has achieved the necessary threshold.
- **SECTION 4.** This shall take effect starting on January 1, 2020.
- **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void. *Introduced for Congressional Debate by Upper St Clair High School.*
