(\$10 fee for every add or drop to your entries/judges after this date. This is to discourage you from making last minute changes, and to help you hold your students accountable.)

Judging will be mostly be conducted by Bentonville West Forensics students, along with judges provided by FJHS, LJHS, & WJHS. Students may enter multiple events in a given round, but double entered policies must be followed. Rounds will NOT be held late to accommodate students with multiple entries.

Refunds will not be granted if students miss rounds due to multiple entries. We will be using Tabroom for registration and tabulation purposes!
