Dear Coaches:

You and your debaters are cordially invited to the *Robert D. Nordyke Memorial Debate Invitational* on **Saturday, November 2, 2019**. This tournament will offer Novice Case List, JV, and Open divisions.

This is a **five- round** tournament with a maximum of 60 teams and entries limited to **six teams** in each division. Entries are \$6/team (for schools hosting an invitational this season) and \$10/team (for schools not hosting this season). Third and fourth year debaters are welcome to judge the Novice division. **Schools will need to bring one judge for every three entries.** Coaches and assistant coaches will be placed in the judging pool if we run short on community judges. Please add your judges in Tabroom to make scheduling less hectic.

All divisions will be direct power-matched with two preset rounds.

All KSHSAA regulations will be enforced. Grievances are due in writing within 10 minutes of conclusion of disputed round.
