**Registration & Fees:** All registration should be complete by October 30 and will take place online. Changes can be made to that registration until *November 1 at 4pm* with no extra charge. **MHSA Rules:** For speech and debate, MHSA AA rules will apply. For drama and SPOI, B/C rules apply with noted exceptions. Double entries will be allowed. Please note that judge restrictions may be lifted if needed.

We encourage all coaches to review MHSA approved changes in the rulebook as this meet will be the first one with many changes.
