

## **A Bill to Eliminate Electoral College Voting to Uphold Democracy**

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** Electoral College votes shall henceforth be eliminated from the election  
3 process of the President and Vice President of the United States. The  
4 electoral votes were created to support the vote of the population which  
5 they represent. However, if the electoral vote is different than the  
6 popular vote, then electors are not representing their populations. By  
7 allowing electoral votes to prevail in elections, the popular vote is  
8 ignored and therefore does not uphold democracy.

9 **SECTION 2.** For the purposes of this legislation, “electoral college” shall be defined as  
10 a body of electors established by the United States Constitution, which  
11 forms every four years for the sole purpose of electing the president and  
12 vice president of the United States.

13 **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall go into effect November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020.

14 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
