

A Bill to Eliminate Electoral College Voting to Uphold Democracy

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2	SECTION 1.	Electoral College votes shall henceforth be eliminated from the election
3		process of the President and Vice President of the United States. The
4		electoral votes were created to support the vote of the population which
5		they represent. However, if the electoral vote is different than the
6		popular vote, then electors are not representing their populations. By
7		allowing electoral votes to prevail in elections, the popular vote is
8		ignored and therefore does not uphold democracy.
9	SECTION 2.	For the purposes of this legislation, "electoral college" shall be defined as
.0		a body of electors established by the United States Constitution, which
1		forms every four years for the sole purpose of electing the president and
L 2		vice president of the United States.
13	SECTION 4.	This legislation shall go into effect November 1st, 2020.
L4	SECTION 5.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
