

# Legislative Calendars

The legislative calendars below are preset and **may not** be modified. An item on the Session 1 calendar or otherwise taken up during Session 1 **MAY NOT** be considered in Session 2 (except for a B/R sponsored by the Presiding Officer of Session 1, which may be postponed to the start of Session 2). However, if a chamber exhausts its Session 1 calendar, it should proceed **immediately** into the Session 2 calendar.

Upon exhausting their own calendar for both sessions:

- SENATE considers the HOUSE's calendar in the order listed below
- HOUSE considers the SENATE's calendar in the order listed below
- NON-QUALIFYING considers the HOUSE's calendar in the order listed below

The **debate time limit** for each chamber is listed below. This time limit **MAY NOT** be extended, but the chamber need not use all available time. Time **MAY NOT** be shifted between items of legislation. Every item is entitled to a sponsorship speech and a first negative *speaking opportunity*.
