

A Bill to Teach LGBTQ-Inclusive Sex Education in Schools

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** Sex education programs must be LGBTQ+ inclusive in schools to inform all
3 high schoolers on sexuality and sexual health.

4 **SECTION 2.** Inclusive programs are those that help youth understand gender identity
5 and sexual orientation with age-appropriate and medically accurate
6 information; emphasize the need for protection during sexual intercourse
7 for people of all identities; and dispel common myths and stereotypes
8 about behavior and identity.

9 **SECTION 3.** The Department of Education will be responsible for the enforcement of
10 the bill.

11 A. Violation from any school not incorporating LGBTQ-inclusive sex
12 education programs will result in a 15% decrease in government
13 funding.

14 **SECTION 4.** This policy will go into effect at the start of the school year in 2021.

15 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
