

A Bill to Teach LGBTQ-Inclusive Sex Education in Schools

- SECTION 1. Sex education programs must be LGBTQ+ inclusive in schools to inform all
 high schoolers on sexuality and sexual health.
- SECTION 2. Inclusive programs are those that help youth understand gender identity
 and sexual orientation with age-appropriate and medically accurate
 information; emphasize the need for protection during sexual intercourse
 for people of all identities; and dispel common myths and stereotypes
 about behavior and identity.
- 9 **SECTION 3.** The Department of Education will be responsible for the enforcement of the bill.
- A. Violation from any school not incorporating LGBTQ-inclusive sex education programs will result in a 15% decrease in government funding.
- **SECTION 4.** This policy will go into effect at the start of the school year in 2021.
- SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
