A Resolution to Expand the Clean Water Act

- **WHEREAS**, Clean waterways are integral to the health of the people and the environment of the United States, and
- **WHEREAS**, small streams have a direct impact on the quality of downstream rivers and bays, and
- **WHEREAS**, wetlands soak up flood-water, reduce erosion, filter pollutants and provide homes for a diverse array of fish and wildlife, and
- **WHEREAS**, the Trump Administration has taken steps to remove regulations on millions of miles of streams and over half the nation's wetlands, and
- **WHEREAS**, reduction in regulation provides a substantial threat to the nation's waterways and people, now, therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED,** That the Student Congress here assembled make the following recommendation for expanding protections under the Clean Water Act to definitely protect waterways that don't have an immediate surface-level connection to larger waterways.
