

A Bill to Repeal the Hyde Amendment to Ensure Safe and Legal Abortion in the United States

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:
- 2 **SECTION 1**. The Hyde Amendment will hereby be repealed.
- **SECTION 2**. The Hyde Amendment will be defined as the amendment first passed in
- 4 1976 and then updated in the Departments of Labor, Health and Human
- Services, and Education, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act of 1994
- that prohibits the federal government from providing funds towards
- abortions that are not in cases of incest, rape, or to save the life of the
- 8 mother.
- 9 **SECTION 3.** The Department of Health and Human Services will oversee this
- transition and ensure that individuals insured under government funded
- insurance have financial coverage for all abortions.
- 12 **SECTION 4.** This action will take place January 1st of 2020.
- SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
