# JUDGES:

You must provide one judge for every six entries or fraction thereof. If you cannot provide the required number of judges, you may hire judges for \$30 each. Please note that you will be charged \$50 for any judges dropped after the registration.

★ Your judges should be familiar with KHSSL rules, and to this end, an online judge training course and handbook geared toward new(er) judges is available. If you would like me to send you these documents, please let me know.

Congress schools will be asked to name one judge from your school who can serve as a scorer or parliamentarian (please make a note in your judges' bio).
