Coaches should register one judge per every 2 teams. Schools only bringing 1 team should register 1 judge.

Coaches should make sure their judges understand the information in the CTMSDL Handbook and our Judges' Instructions. We'll hold a judges' workshop at the tournament. Coaches are encouraged to bring volunteer timers.
