

The Political Transparency Act of 2019

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:
2. **SECTION 1.** All public corporations shall be required to publicly disclose all financial
3. contributions to political causes.
4. **SECTION 2.** “Public corporations” are defined as any issuers of securities registered
5. national securities exchanges.
6. **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall be implemented by the Securities Exchange Commission.
7. **SECTION 4.** This legislation shall go into effect on October 1, 2020.
8. **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

The American Workers Promotion Act of 2019

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:
2. **SECTION 1.** The United States Federal Government shall cease awarding contracts to
3. American businesses classified as “Outsourcing Companies” based on Section 2
4. of this legislation.
5. **SECTION 2.** For the purposes of this legislation, U.S. companies that either manufacture over
6. 50% of their products or provide over 50% of their services outside the jurisdiction
7. of the United States shall be defined as an “Outsourcing Company.”
8. **SECTION 3.** This legislation shall go into effect immediately upon passage.
9. **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

The Education Fulfillment Act of 2019

1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:
2. **SECTION 1.** Starting at the beginning of their next applicable school year, all states must
3. increase the salaries of all public school teachers by 5%.
4. **SECTION 2.** The United States Department of the Treasury shall provide grants to each state
5. equal to the funds necessary to fund the mandate listed in Section 1.
6. **A.** States will be responsible for distributing the appropriate grant funds in Section
7. 2 to their respective school districts.
8. **SECTION 3.** Funding for this legislation will be derived from the U.S. Department of
9. Education's budget for the Fiscal Year 2021.
10. **SECTION 4.** This legislation will go into effect starting in the Fiscal Year 2021.
11. **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
