## **The American Workers Promotion Act of 2019**

- 4. of this legislation.
- 5. **SECTION 2.** For the purposes of this legislation, U.S. companies that either manufacture over
- 50% of their products or provide over 50% of their services outside the jurisdiction
- of the United States shall be defined as an "Outsourcing Company."
- 8. **SECTION 3**. This legislation shall go into effect immediately upon passage.
- 9. **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

## The Education Fulfillment Act of 2019

- 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:
- 2. **SECTION 1.** Starting at the beginning of their next applicable school year, all states must
- increase the salaries of all public school teachers by 5%.
- 4. **SECTION 2**. The United States Department of the Treasury shall provide grants to each state
- 5. equal to the funds necessary to fund the mandate listed in Section 1.
- 6. **A.** States will be responsible for distributing the appropriate grant funds in Section
- 7. 2 to their respective school districts.
- 8. **SECTION 3.** Funding for this legislation will be derived from the U.S. Department of
- 9. Education's budget for the Fiscal Year 2021.
- section 4. This legislation will go into effect starting in the Fiscal Year 2021.
- 11. **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
