



# Fairview Freeze

You are invited to Fairview High School on Saturday, January 18, 2020.

## THE BIG STUFF:

- Initial entry limit of 6 per event, but we anticipate clearing the waitlist
- If you enter many competitors in a single event, your students may hit one another
- \$10 per individual entry; \$20 per team.
- All rounds will be powered
- All undefeated debaters will break to finals, subject to judge availability
- Places will be determined by win-loss, strength of opp, and speaker points
- **Interp and speaking students may double enter within the wave and across; for students within waves it is their responsibility to get to rounds. They may not receive full prep. Debaters may only double across waves in non-debate events.**
- Events will use NSDA rules with NSDA topics (**CHSAA for Value Debate, Impromptu and Creative Storytelling with impromptu draw in room**)
- A coach or responsible adult must be on-site at all times and checked into judge or in tab (**This is so we know how to locate you in case of an accident or incident**)
- We will assess a \$20 fee if you cannot provide at least 1 judge throughout the day.
- Community members will be paid \$9 per round
- Team awards will be determined by percentage of entries, not total numbers

## A few things to note:

- Enter from the top part of the school where registration will take place
- All cars and buses should be parked in the senior parking lot, which is just beyond the main circle drive on Greenbriar
- Fairview ramps are STEEP, please keep your students from running or playing on them
- Fast food is not available within walking distance from the school, food will be available
- Breakfast, lunch, and snacks will be provided for judges and coaches
- Students are expected to remain in the Student Center when not competing
- Please do not enter classrooms before judges are present
- Note that all tobacco use and products are not permitted on the Fairview campus



### **Schedule:**

- Rounds will be run as quickly as possible: postings may be earlier than scheduled
- Wave A: CX, Value Debate, HI, DI, OO, INF, Extemp, Impromptu
- Wave B: PF, LD, Duo, PI, Creative Storytelling, POI

**Round 1 Wave B:** 10:00 AM

**Round 2 Wave A:** 11:30 AM

**Round 2 Wave B:** 1:30 PM

**Round 3 Wave A:** 3:00 PM

**Round 3 Wave B:** 5:00 PM

**Finals:** 6:30 PM (Double breaks will be accommodated as needed)

**Awards:** 7:30 PM or as soon as possible

**Pre-Registration:** Pre-registration will be on Tabroom.com All numbers will be considered final on January 15th at 5pm. Drops after this may be made online but will not reduce fees.

**Fees:** Entry fees will be \$10 per individual entry; \$20 for teams. Checks should be made payable to Fairview High School c/o Speech and Debate Team. **If at all possible, bring payment to registration instead of paying by mail.**

**Judging and Tabulation:** In order to ensure that the meet runs on time, we will expect full participation from all coaches on site. We view the running of a tournament as a collaborative effort. This involves assignments ranging from judges table, to tab, and judging.

All coaches or parent chaperons must be willing and available to donate at least two rounds throughout the day. We ask you bring 1 speech/PF judge for every 6 entries and 1 LD/CX/Value Debate judge for every 4. Community members will be paid \$9 per round.

**Day of Event:** All dropped entries must be recorded by 7:20 AM. If you are running late, please call or text Kristina Getty at 303-710-5091.
