Competition is open to students in grades six through eight. Dual entry for novice and experienced students is allowed. There will be three rounds with a single judge in each section, plus a final round for the top eight competitors in each event. Judges

Schools must furnish one judge for every *five* entries (note: one duo pair equals a single entry when calculating your judge quota). Parents, teachers and high school students who have experience in speech may serve as judges.

Fling round

The Pike School *Stand Up for Speech* Tournament will have <u>one optional</u> "fling" round with two events in between the preliminary rounds and the final round. Students may enter in *either* Original Literature or Big Questions Debate.

• Resources for Big Questions Debate can be found on the National Speech and Debate Association (NSDA) web site. The Big Questions Debate resolution is: *Objective morality exists*. Big Questions Debate teams can be a single student or a pair of students.

• <u>An event description and ballot regarding Original Literature</u> can be found on the Massachusetts Middle School Speech League (MMSSL) web site. Original Literature can be performed by one or two students.

JUDGES:

Each school must provide at one judge per *five* entries.

FEES

\$7 per solo student entry; \$14 per duo. \$3 per fling round entry for either Original Literature or Big Questions Debate. Checks payable to The Pike School.

DEADLINE: Competitors must be registered on Tabroom.com by *Wednesday*, *February 26*, 2020 at 9:00 p.m. Fees and the number of judges from your school are considered final at that time.

PARKING: The parking lot at Pike is small. If you are able to carpool it may save you the need to park off site.

GENDER-NEUTRAL BATHROOMS: There are gender-neutral bathrooms on the first and second floor of the Upper School.
