2	SECTION 1.	No Federal funds may be obligated or expended for any use of military
3		force in or against Iran unless Congress has declared war or enacted
4		specific statutory authorization for such use of military force after the
5		enactment of this Act that meets the requirements of the War Powers

7	SECTION 2.	Iran shall be defined as any military unit affiliated or working with the
8		Iranian government and armed forces. This will include any foreign

10		the Iranian government.
